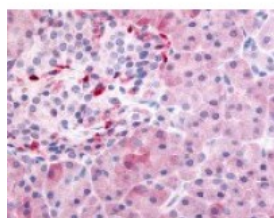

APPLICATIONS:	PDE7B antibody can be used in ELISA starting at 1:10000, Western Blot starting at 1:500 - 1:2000, immunohistochemistry starting at 1:200 - 1:300, and immunofluorescence starting at 1:200 - 1:1000.
USER NOTE:	Optimal dilutions for each application to be determined by the researcher.
SPECIFICITY:	BLAST analysis of the peptide immunogen showed no homology with other human proteins.
IMMUNOGEN:	PDE7B antibody was raised against a peptide located in the near N-Terminus of PDE7B (Human).
HOST SPECIES:	Rabbit

PURIFICATION:	Immunoaffinity Chromatography
PHYSICAL STATE:	Liquid
BUFFER:	PBS, 0.1% sodium azide.
STORAGE CONDITIONS:	PDE7B antibody should be stored long term (months) at -80 °C and short term (days) at 4 °C. As with all antibodies avoid freeze/thaw cycles.
CLONALITY:	Polyclonal
CONJUGATE:	Unconjugated

Background

BACKGROUND:	Phosphodiesterase 7B, a cAMP-specific phosphodiesterase, has been shown to affect cAMP-mediated neural
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activity and cAMP metabolism in the brain. PDE7B activity is inhibited by dipyridamole, IBMX, and SCH51866. At least three splice variants have been isolated for PDE7B from rats and they show tissue specific expression patterns.
